For many years there were only a few legal patients who could freely speak about how cannabis helped them. Those were the people in the Investigative New Drug (IND) Program who received medical marijuana from the Federal Government. One of the IND patients, Elvy Musikka, now an Oregon resident, traveled around the nation telling her story and convincing people that marijuana was indeed medicinally beneficial. Over and over Elvy told the media, groups and individuals about how marijuana helped her when all other medicines and medical procedures didn't work. They saw the marijuana she received from the federal government and were told how it kept her from going totally blind.

Elvy's story helped change public opinion and there are almost 20,000 patients now legally registered in the Oregon Medical Marijuana Program. This is your opportunity to meet Elvy in person and hear about her past and current efforts to make this medicine available to all who need it.
